The Trinity Video Series

This series is about appreciating the enormous role the Trinity plays in the Christian faith. How it is a delight, as it provides a relationship with God experiencing His love, rescue, and transformation.

Video 1, "The Trinity Revealed" introduces how the Bible uniquely reveals God as a Trinity—3 persons in 1, the Father, Son (Jesus), and Holy Spirit, as we see Jesus' baptism. Jesus makes numerous statements to His disciples asserting His unity with God the Father, and accepts the declaration by one of His disciples after Jesus' resurrection, that Jesus is both Lord and God. This unique revelation by God of Himself is one of great beauty and practicality, providing a basis for the Christian faith.





Video 2, "The Trinity is Love" explores Jesus' bold statement that the Father loved the Son from

before the world began, that is from eternity, thus defining a key attribute of God's nature, namely, eternal love. The significance of this eternal love extends to humanity, who are created in God's image. This implies that love is a central aspect of human nature, reflecting God's own essence. Just as we desire intimacy in human relationships, so God likewise made us to have an intimacy with Himself.

In Video 3, "The Father Sends Jesus", looks at how this intimacy has been disrupted due to the rebellion of Adam and Eve which led to a distorted, self-centered love within humanity, resulting in a broken image of what we were meant to be. Despite this brokenness, the Trinity does not abandon us. The Father sends Jesus, who shows us not only what God is like, but also what we are meant to be as beings created in His image. However, this rebellion against Him deserves punishment, indeed, an eternal separation from God, an issue that we cannot rectify.





Video 4 "The Trinity Pays the Price" dives into the central Christian belief of how God, through Jesus, offers a path for humanity to be reconciled to Him and rescued from eternal punishment. He willingly took on the sins of humanity, died as a ransom for many, and endured separation from the Father during His crucifixion. Based on His resurrection, God offers salvation as a gift and sends His Holy Spirit to those who believe, allowing them to be spiritually reborn and transformed into the image of God. This ultimate sacrifice demonstrates God's immense love.

Video 5 "The Trinity - Our Response" calls for a personal decision to turn towards God, accept His forgiveness.Our transformed heart allows us to obey the 2 greatest commandments, namely loving God and one's neighbor. This, becomes a delight and not a chore. Only the Trinity provides such a salvation.
